Hahnemühle Sumi-E 80 gsm

**These sample sheets of Sumi-e paper are coming to you courtesy of
Hahnemühle Paper.**

This rice paper is 80gsm, 100% cellulose, natural white, unsized and unbuffered. It is proving to be a good choice for Cyanotype.

Instructions for coating:

The paper is extremely absorbent, so for small prints it is best to pour your solution onto a piece of glass or plexiglass and lay the paper in a u-shape into the puddle, then release the paper gently and allow it to absorb and flatten. For larger sheets, a brush can be used. The emulsion will absorb almost all the way to the edges of the paper. It is a strong paper and you can hang it to dry.

The back and front are hard to tell apart, the back has a slightly more fibrous surface.

Do not tape the paper down or the negative to the paper unless your tape is not very sticky, because the tape will pull off the topmost paper fibers.

Sumi-e comes in 20 sheet pads. Each sheet in the pad is interleaved between a thin piece of white paper to protect the Sumi-e. The Sumi-e has a fibrous look somewhat like parchment paper.

Bostick & Sullivan has Sumi-e paper in 12X16 20 sheet pads.
